MN5 GOP Endorses Jennifer Zielinski for Congress

The Republican Party of Minnesota's 5th Congressional District held its convention this last Saturday April 21st in Crystal, MN to endorse its candidate for Congress.

Two candidates were vying for the opportunity to go up against Keith Ellison in November. Christopher Chamberlin, resident of St. Cloud who had previously unsuccessfully ran for President, Governor and briefly US Senate against party activist, CD5 2017 Volunteer of the Year, and South Minneapolis resident Jennifer Zielinski.

Ms. Zielinski won by a landslide majority of the delegates and will be the Republican endorsed candidate. Jennifer was born and raised in the Twin Cities and currently resides in South Minneapolis.
